PETER KALBA GRABS NEVADA STATE INTERMEDIATE TITLE

Paul Friedman & George Barr Also Big Int. Winners

The Chicago Bar Point Club flexed it's "Intermediate" muscle with an effective sweep of the Nevada State Championships. The event, held 22–27 April, drew 250 worldwide players to the Four Queens Hotel in Las Vegas. Former Chicagoan Howard Markowitz directed, assisted by other Chicagoans Joann Feinstein and John Brussel.

Bar Point Club codirector Peter Kalba scored the biggest tournament payday of his life in winning the Intermediate title. He won seven matches in a row, including two of the last three at double match-point, to claim the grand prize. In the finals, Kalba defeated another red-hot Chicagoan, Paul Friedman, in an exciting match-deciding game.

George Barr completed the Chicagoland Intermediate sweep by grabbing the

1st Consolation trophy. These incredible results show the depth of Chicago Bar Point Club play.
