18th illinois state challenge cup

BAR POINT CLUB WINS 18TH CHALLENGE CUP Peoria Club charge falls short

Steady play helped the Chicago Bar Point Club win the 1998 Illinois State Challenge Cup. The seven active Illinois backgammon clubs sent their 1997 top six players to The Old Main Inn in Wheaton, Illinois to do battle at the 18th annual affair on 31 January.

After two rounds of play, the Winnetka Club had a 9-8 lead over the BPC. But following four wins in round 3, the Bar Pointers never looked back.

The Peoria Club mounted a late surge to trail 20-19 after the 5th round, but wins by Gary Kay, Herb Roman, Phyllis Smolinski and Paul Franks in round 6 brought the BPC win total to 24. Peoria finished second with 22 victories followed by Sangamon Valley (21), Winnetka (18), Games People Play (14), Bloomington-Normal (14) and the defending champion Pub Club (13).
