### PEORIA WINS CLOSEST CHALLENGE CUP EVER

Bar Point Club and Winnetka Tie for 2nd

Hail Peoria! The backgammon club from Central Illinois has captured the 2001 Illinois State Challenge Cup in an incredibly close battle. Seven teams converged on Bloomington, Illinois at Ride The Nine to fight 4 February. Their mission was to
