Realistically, Black is just trying to cut his losses in this money game. He was hoping to run out (at the least) one man in hopes of avoiding the backgammon, but he rolled a puny 4-1 which limps out only part way.

Black played 24/19, running as far as he could. This accomplishes nothing. If

White rolls an ace, she'll hit the checker on her 1-point. Then Black will need double 3s or better to escape the backgammon, whether he's anchored on the ace or he's run a man to the 6-point. Therefore Black should keep the anchor on the 1-point and thereby prevent White's double 1s from playing.

As simple as this choice may be, I've made this hasty play myself and seen others do it as well. A


