

DANNY KLEINMAN'S 2.7 RULE FOR BEARING OFF THE LAST TWO CHECKERS

In the very end game, you come down to a position like this and roll a 6-2. What is the best play?

Money game. Black to play 6-2.




Of course you can count all the misses. If you play 6/off, 3/1, you miss on 1-1, 2-1, 3-1, 4-1, 5-1, 2-3, 2-4, 2-5, 3-4, 3-5, and 4-5. That's 21 rolls.

If you instead play 6/off, 6/4, you miss on all aces and deuces except 2-2 for a total of 19 rolls. So 6/off, 6/4 is better.

Counting is a good way, except you might miss or forget your count, or you might be playing with a clock and pressured by time. That's where Danny Kleinman's 2.7 Bearoff Rule comes into play. The rule states that whenever you have two checkers left with one move remaining, position the two checkers closest to 2.7 pips apart. In our example, we had to choose between five pips apart (checkers on the 6- and 1-point) vs. one pip apart (checkers on the 4- and 3-point. Since one is closer to 2.7 than five, we know immediately that 4, 3 placement is better than 6, 1.

Here's another example:


Money game. Black to play 5-1.



After bearing off the 5, you can move the final ace either 5/4 or 3/2. Spacing on the 5- and 2-point = 3. Spacing on the 4and 3-point = 1. Since three is closer to 2.7 than 1, the best play is 5/off, 3/2.

This works in every instance except one:

Money game. Black to play 6-1.



Danny's rule suggests that checkers on the 6- and 3-points bear off quicker than checkers on the 5- and 4-points. In fact, both configurations bear off with 26 rolls. But even in this one exception, you still get the best play by following the 2.7 Rule. Δ
